Established as a club in 1993, the Valley Woodturners has a membership of over 160 and is Chapter 195 of the American Association of Woodturners.

Purpose:

Each monthly meeting features a demonstration or discussion of a topic related to woodturning

One of our most interesting activities is "SHOW AND TELL" where members share their successes, failures, ideas and new techniques. **Monthly Theme Projects** challenge members to produce a specific item—this month a vase, next month—a craft item, etc. Members discuss sources of supplies, learn from informal mini-seminars and help organize and plan club activities.

Membership Fees:

- The annual dues are \$35.00 per year (January 1 to December 31)
- Family members living in the same household are charged half-price
- \$10.00 per year for Students

Seminar Fees:

- Seminars are organized where we bring in local / regional or world class turners to demonstrate and share their skills and ideas.
- Seminar fees vary according to the rate charged by the guest demonstrator(s) and other associated costs.
- Seminars or other similar events are normally priced higher for non-members

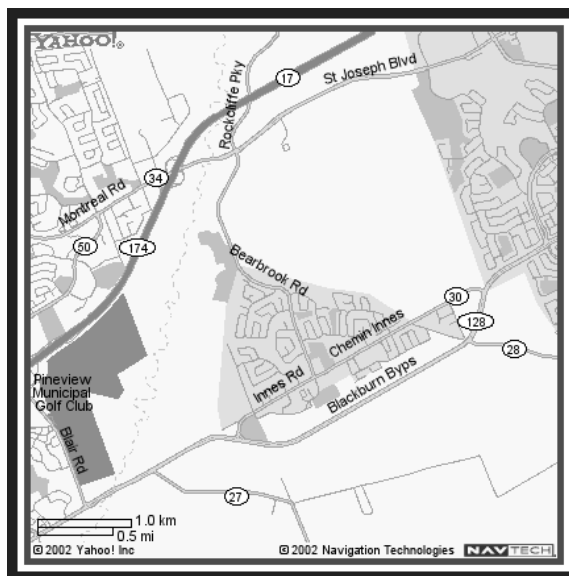
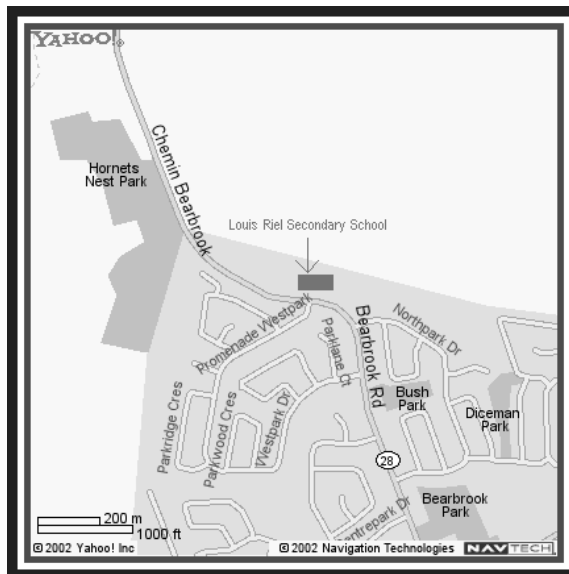
